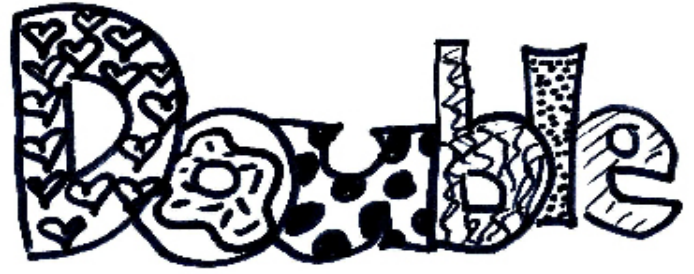

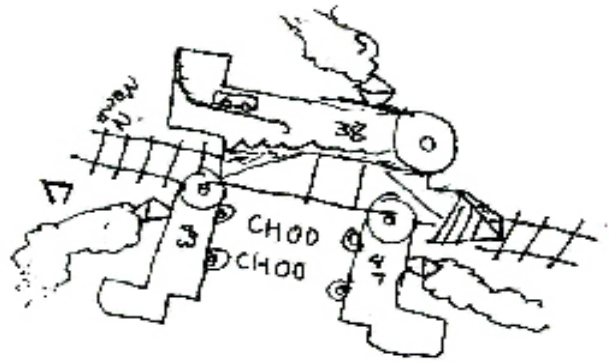

Mostly A's: Elbow pasta

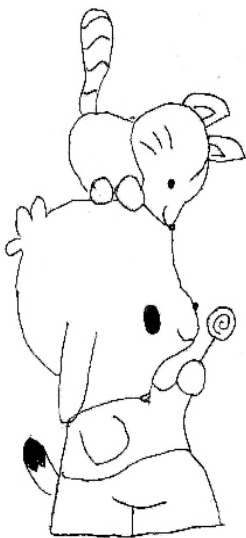
